The interior floor measurements are taken at the flattest portion of the bottom of the tub before the walls curve upwards. Thanks!

My plumber just installed this tub and said there is no way to secure it to the floor. The tub is only secured by the drain so the back part of the tub can pivot around it which concerns me. Can you please advise as to correct installation?

Hello! On the underside of the tub are four leveling feet. Here you will want to apply a dollop of neutral cure silicone to the bottom of each foot. Once the drain and feet have cured, your will need to go around the tub base, where the skirt of the tub sits just above the floor (all the weight should be on the leveling feet) and apply a bead of neutral cure silicone around the entire perimeter of the tub. Thanks!

Hi, Laney! The shape of the tub is what will ultimately determine how wide it is at the flattest part at the bottom. In general, most slipper style tubs (where it come up higher on one or both ends) do tend to be more narrow. This is because all the walls are more narrow which helps to achieve the more drastic slipper design. Comfort level is subjective and something that will vary from person to person. As a woman, size US 24, I can get in and out of this tub. It isn't too terrible considering the walls angle outwards as they go up, though it is snug.
